
A variety of tools including guest speakers pre- and post-tests, multiple choice test banks, simulations and project-based unit assessment tools are used to measure student progress.

# Money Camp Program

## Advanced Level

Through a blend of classroom based instruction and college level online course work at the University of Michigan, students gain the fundamental knowledge, skills, and tools of finance and the ability to apply them everywhere, in personal and professional situations. They acquire skills in using different decision-making tools, and learn to make sound personal and professional financial decisions.

**Classroom Based:** Instruction for each session is provided by Money Camp's instructors that utilizes a variety of interactive tools to educate students on being able to value the impact of different frameworks for decision-making.

**Online Coursework:** As part of the program, students are enrolled in a certificate course at the University of Michigan. Students that complete the program will receive a verifiable certification for their resume and online profile to showcase their achievements. . Money Camp's instructors monitor student's online course work and provide support to ensure the students progress and complete the program.

- The concept of Time Value of Money (TVM) and apply related tools and frameworks to everyday decisions
- Why finance is everywhere and how it affects all of us
- Impulse buying, saving, investing, and taking out loans
- An understanding of the financial world, an appreciation for the beauty and power of finance
